Deciding what day Easter will fall on is a matter of great importance to Christian churches because it celebrates the resurrection of Jesus Christ. It's so important, according to Panos Antsaklis, PhD, a professor at Norte Dame University, that in the 4th century A.D., a group of Christian leaders came together to officially decide how to calculate Easter's date. Their decision: Easter is to be celebrated on the first Sunday after the first full moon following the vernal equinox. Happy Spring!


