Their decision: Easter is to be celebrated on the first Sunday after the first full moon following the vernal equinox. Happy Spring!

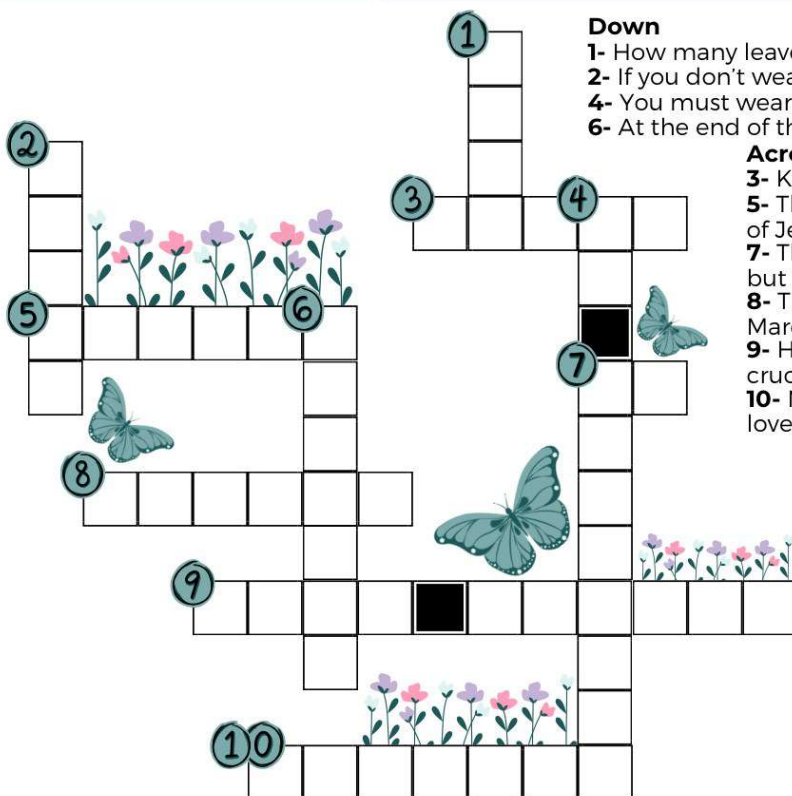

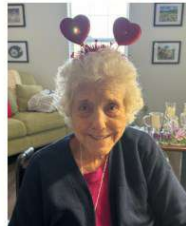
